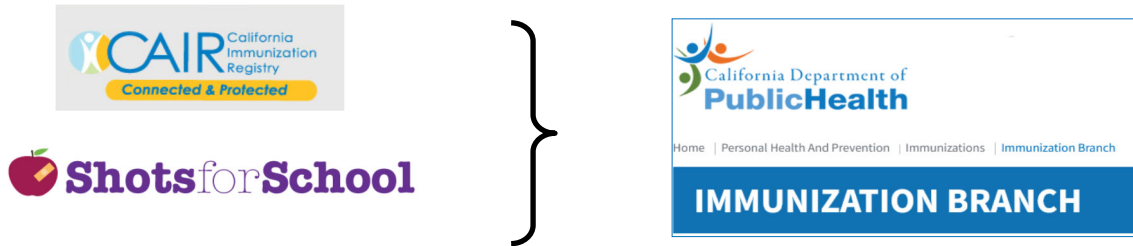


CAIRweb and Shots for School Website is Moving

Frequently Asked Question:

“How often do I have to revisit conditional immunization records?”

According to the California Code of Regulations section 6035(b), the governing authority shall review records of any pupil admitted conditionally to a school at least every 30 days from the day of admission, inform the parent/guardian of the remaining required vaccine doses until all required immunizations are received or an exemption is filed, and update the immunization information in the pupil's record.”
